FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS
OF LAW AND ORDER

On October 12, 1978, a hearing was held before the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina concerning the charges and allegations preferred by the Board against Theodore Carl Rozema, M.D., at which Dr. Rozema appeared in person and was represented by counsel. Following the presentation of evidence as shown by the record, and consideration of the evidence concerning the charges and Dr. Rozema's history and present practice, the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina finds facts and concludes and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On December 10, 1976, Theodore Carl Rozema, respondent, plead guilty to and was convicted in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Massachusetts of the charge that he did knowingly, wilfully and feloniously extort by use of force, violence and fear money, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1951 and 1952, a felony.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Grounds exist for the revocation of the license heretofore issued by this Board to Theodore Carl Rozema, M.D.

ORDER

It is therefore ORDERED that the license heretofore issued by this Board to Theodore Carl Rozema, M.D. to practice medicine in the State of North Carolina be and the same is hereby revoked.

It is further ordered, however, that this revocation and order of revocation of Theodore Carl Rozema, M.D.'s license to practice

That for a period of three (3) years from this date he be and remain of good behavior in his personal conduct and in his practice of medicine, that he violate no laws of the State of North Carolina or of the United States; that in his practice of medicine he conform to the requirements of good and proper medical care for patients and the professional and ethical requirements of his profession and that he furnish the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina such information concerning his conduct and practice of medicine and appear before this Board as he may be requested to do.
